ELIGIBILITY:

- Women residing in or with strong ties to Appalachia are eligible to submit.
- Artists may submit (3) pieces).
- Entrants must be at least 16 years or older.
- Artists may enter only their original, untutored work NO REPRODUCTIONS.
- Artwork must have been completed in the last three years and must be visibly dated (suggested on the back).
- ARTWORK PREVIOUSLY SHOWN IN THIS EXHIBITION MAY NOT BE ENTERED.
- All artwork selected for the exhibit must remain as part of the exhibit for the duration of ALL exhibits (September 29, 2018 April 26, 2019).
- The curator and gallery reserves the right to photograph works for educational and publicity purposes.
- The curator may reject work that in her judgment is not as originally represented in the application.

ARTWORK CONDITION AND SIZE LIMITATIONS:

- Hanging work MUST BE FRAMED AND WIRED and ready to display. SAW-TOOTH HANGERS AND CLIP FRAMES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.
- Hanging work may not exceed 56" wide, unless it can be suspended/hung from ceiling or cross bars...
- Installation style art pieces may not exceed 3'wide x 6'high. The artist or persons working for the artist must set up the installation, in a location selected by the curator.
- Glass or plexi-glass must be used over water media, drawings, prints, photographs and 2-D mixed media artworks.
- The curator will have the final decision regarding proper artwork condition and location of each piece.
- Perishable items will not be accepted.
- While inside each gallery insurance will be provide for all art artwork.
- Art must be dropped off at Monongalia Arts Center, Morgantown, WV (Sept. 29 or Oct. 1, 2018) and picked up at Ohio University Multicultural Center Art Gallery, Athens, OH (April 26, 2019).
- Art will be transported between galleries by Ohio University Moving Services. ARTISTS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR INSURING WORK WHILE IN TRANSIT FROM GALLERY TO GALLERY.
- PLEASE ADD 35% COMMISSION TO YOUR SALE PRICE

How to Submit Your Slides:

- DIGITAL FORMAT ONLY
- All entries will be judged from digital images sent via email only! QUALITY SLIDES ARE CRITICAL.
- Image size requirements: RGB, 1920 pixels on the longest side at 250 DPI JPEG Only.
- Label each JPEG last name_first initial_number of piece (smith_i_01).
- A contact sheet including thumbnails, your name, medium, titles of each piece and price of each must accompany the submission form. IF NOT FOR SALE, SUBMIT AN INSURANCE REPLACEMENT PRICE.
- Email your art JPEGs, your name, titles of work, medium, price and size of your work (in that order)
- Email one paragraph expressing how living or having ties to Appalachia has influenced your life and therefore your art.
- Artists are required to provide a co-op fee of \$35.00 to be used for set-up, marketing, web promotion costs and transporting art.
